Eligible species include: American wigeon, Green-winged teal, Lesser scaup, Northern pintail and Wood duck. In addition, entries this year were required to include a hunting-related accessory and/or portray the theme "Celebrating Our Waterfowl Hunting Heritage." Non-eligible species or other designs that depict uses of the stamp for sporting, conservation and/or collecting purposes are optional.
